Motorists must yield to pedestrians in crosswalks.

Motorists must allow at least 2 feet (preferably 3 feet) when passing bicyclists.

Pedestrians must use crosswalks whenever possible and use sidewalks when available.

Pedestrians should face traffic and walk/run on the extreme edge when on the road.

Bicycles are considered vehicles and riders must follow the rules that apply to motor vehicles, including obeying traffic signs and signals.

Bicyclists must ride on the right side with traffic and yield to pedestrians.
