




Events - Speeding [> 6 mph over speed limit]






Events - Phone Use





Expert-level roads








Analyzed "Dangerous Road Segments"

These tend to be major roadways, where the heaviest congestion occurs during rush hour.








Five "Most Distracted" Segments to inform investments


- Massachusetts Avenue from Shawmut Avenue to Harrison Avenue
